

11th Nuneaton Scouts – Behaviour Plan

Consequences of Poor Behaviour:

- Young Person or Volunteer being upset
- Young Person being hurt
- Young Person not understanding the activity
- Not enough time to complete the activity
- Planned activities being scaled down to fit the abilities of the group
- Young Person not feeling able to continue in Scouting due to fear of bullying or frustration at wasted time
- Adults not wanting to volunteer anymore, therefore risking a sections ability to function at current levels

Our Code of Conduct:

General Behaviour

- Respect others: Treat members and leaders with kindness, respect and consideration.
- Follow instructions: Listen to your leaders. Put your hand up to speak.
- Be inclusive: Scouting supports diversity. Ensure everyone feels welcome and part of the group.
- No bullying or harassment: Speak and act respectfully; bullying, teasing, fighting, unwanted physical contact or intimidation will not be tolerated.

Personal Responsibility

- Be honest: Always tell the truth and take responsibility for your actions.
- Take care of belongings: Look after your own kit and respect others' property.
- Watch our language: Beware that the words we use can upset others.
- Be a role model: Set a good example for younger or newer members.
- Uniform: Wear the uniform with pride.

Activities

- Be safe: Avoid risky or foolish behaviour that could harm yourself or others.
- Adhere to rules: Follow all rules specific to the activity.
- Participate fully: Engage in all activities to the best of your ability.
- Work as a team: Support your group.

Follow up actions

- Failure to follow any rule above once: Member has warning from Leader
- Failure to follow any rule(s) above repeatedly in one night or a significant breach of the rule(s): Member is withdrawn from activity until home time and communication with parents to explain why.
- Repeated failure to follow the any rules over multiple meetings or a single serious breach of the rule(s): Parent/Guardians contacted. Member may be asked not to attend future Scouting events.
